Learn the valuable skills needed to respond to critical incidents before law enforcement or other first responders arrive.








Course Description

This course is designed to help civilians prepare for acts of violence (specifically active shooters). Students will be shown statistically that acts of violence can occur anywhere and will be trained how to **Prepare** for, **Prevent** and **React** to an active shooter. It is narrowly focused to ensure training objectives are understood and the critical core actions paired with the correct mentality, can be easily practiced and applied during an actual emergency.

Learning Objectives

-  **AWARENESS**
Participants will be aware that active shooting and violent events can happen anywhere.
-  **MENTALITY**
Understand the mentality required to prevent and survive an active shooter event.
-  **PREVENTION**
Prior to an active shooter carrying out a shooting, students will be taught to recognize the stages of an active shooter and opportunities for intervention/prevention.
-  **ACTION**
Understand and apply the E.S.C.A.P.E. active shooter protocols during an active shooter event.
-  **SCENARIO**
Give participants the opportunity to do an impromptu evaluation of the events, applying the skills they have just learned. The instructor will review recent or well known active shooting events and walk the class through them.
-  **COMMUNICATION**
Recognize the life saving value of time. The instructor will demonstrate and encourage the use of AEGIX AIM technology as it relates to the benefits of real time, critical active communication.
-  **POLICE RESPONSE**
Realize what is helpful to do when police respond as well as actions that could be harmful or dangerous.
